ANNUAL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

FISCAL YEAR 2011

The American Red Cross is a non-profit humanitarian organization that provides relief to victims of disaster and helps people prevent, prepare for and respond to emergencies. The American Red Cross Broward County Chapter offers Disaster Preparedness & Relief, International Services, Preparedness Health & Safety Services, and Service to the Armed Forces. Between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011, the American Red Cross Broward County Chapter provided the following services to the residents of Broward County:

Disaster Preparedness & Relief

- The Red Cross responded to 172 local disasters.
- 192 families received food, clothing and shelter from the Red Cross.
- 191 people attended community disaster education presentations.

International Services

- 27 International Social Services contacts were provided, including tracing services related to natural disasters, armed conflict and the Holocaust.
- Nationally, the Red Cross collected more than \$300 million in aid for the earthquake and tsunami victims in Japan.

Preparedness Health & Safety Services

- 5,538 people were trained in lifesaving CPR, and First-Aid courses.
- 957 trained to be Authorized Instructors.
- 190,199 people enrolled in aquatic programs.

Service to the Armed Forces (SAF)

- 514 emergency messages with urgent news of family illness, deaths and births were delivered to and from local military families.
- 1,460 people participated in Get to Know Us presentations.
- Over 200 local military members and veterans from the VA Hospital received holiday stockings through the Red Cross' Stockings for the Troops program.
